Cromwell’s Big Fruit Reserve spiced up

Recently The Otago Buzz opened up in Cromwell. It’s a tiny mobile shop - in a caravan – with gifts and souvenirs. The Otago Buzz is the first business to receive a trading licence for The Big Fruit Reserve.

Owner of The Otago Buzz, Karin Hermens-Jolink says “I love Cromwell and Central Otago.

Our town is expanding, facilities are improving and the future is looking bright.

I’d love to contribute to that growth and show visitors what this region has to offer. Lots of tourists are still driving by our beautiful town and that is such a shame. This town and region have so much to offer”.

Karin moved to Cromwell from the Netherlands over a year ago with her husband and two children after they fell in love with the country during two

holidays. But to be honest, she drove by Cromwell too.

Being a tourism graduate she decided this shouldn’t have happened if the town could just show what it has to offer seen from the State Highways.

So earlier this year, after a friend funnelled all of her ideas into a mobile shop the preparations began. The search for a caravan and stock and transforming it into a shop.

The design on the outside is influenced by the regional colour scheme – The Otago Buzz is an official partner of Central Otago’s Regional Identity, A World of Difference, and the curvy pattern represents Central’s rolling hills and the blue water.

Local handmade products Karin wants to offer tourists something to take home in their suitcase or backpack. For locals it’s a place to buy that one special, quirky and affordable gift.

Part of the stock is made out of local materials sand, driftwood, stones, tiles, merino wool and other NZ fabrics.

“I met some very lovely and clever people who are capable of making the most stunning things. And I know there are many more out there. I’m hoping to create a centre of all those local treasures.

Once it gets warmer I would like to organise some smaller outside activities too.

I think it would be a wonderful experience for tourists and local kids to see someone working on a spinning wheel in front of my caravan or to be able to paint their own rocks through a small workshop.

I want my shop to be a reason for visitors to stick around longer in the area and to introduce them to Central Otago and Cromwell. Hopefully in the near future this will grow into a bigger lively strip of food trucks and mobile shops”.

Who are you voting for next month?

The general election is just six Saturdays away, and I can honestly say that I’m unsure which political party to support.

I’m your classic swinging voter – having voted Social Credit, National, Labour and NZ First since my first election back in 1975. To be fair, I’ve mostly voted National although, one election cycle, I was in the Amazon so didn’t vote at all.

I’ve voted under both the old and new electoral systems, and despite its quirks, find the latter much more representative and democratic. One election – 1978 – Social Credit gained 21% of the vote and just two seats. Normally, I’d be expecting a change in government this time. Not since Keith Holyoake and the 1960s has any party won a fourth term, and most administrations run out of energy and ideas.

Up until the extraordinary upheaval of the past fortnight, I was thinking that Bill English might pull it off. We joined the National Caucus at the same time – in 1990 – and he was always steady, bright and capable. But leadership material? Not so sure.

Meanwhile the drama of this past period has consumed its originator. It was Metiria Turei’s welfare speech that put the skids under both Labour leader Andrew Little, and her. And has very probably accounted for the inflated poll numbers of NZ First and TOP as well.

Small parties only do well, when big parties stuff it up.

It’s worth recalling that the last time Bill English led National, it dived to just 21% of the vote in the 2002 election. That was my Amazon election – I got out of the jungle after a month and couldn’t believe the result. That was the ‘worm’ election.

As a general rule though, and despite the MMP electoral system, I choose either National or Labour because they are the only parties capable of forming a government. It will be their policies, and their people, who guide the next three years.

Certainly, Jacinda Ardern has boosted Labour and put it back in the election frame. Realistically, Labour’s core support is always around 33% so all we are currently seeing in the polls is Labour voters coming home.

She’s a smart and personable lady but also very pragmatic. The next six weeks of campaigning, media pressure and TV debates will test whether her initial impression can be sustained. At least, we will have a contested election this time. And that can’t be a bad thing.
