What do parents want for their school children?

Last week Cromwell College sent out a broadcast email seeking parents' input into the school's strategic plan. The board and staff have been consulted, and now it is the parents' turn to contribute.

Normally, I'd demur from contribution for all sorts of reasons although mostly because strategic plans leave me cold. As I regularly inform my Otago regional council colleagues, the Devil lies in the detail, not the strategy.

You can have as many strategies as you like – it's practical plans that count. Where do you want to go, what's the detailed map to get there, and how are you progressing?

Cromwell's board of trustees is legally obliged to go through the process but they're doing it sincerely. They genuinely want to know what people think of their school, their leadership, their schooling and their intentions.

So I urge parents not to junk the e-mail. Get involved, tell them. It's your child's education at stake and Cromwell's educational future for the next three years.

I have. And one thing I've replied, is that the College has set its standards too low if it aspires just to be "the best rural school in New Zealand."

Quite apart from defining what that means, I'd prefer they aspire to something practical - to be the best school in Central Otago and the Lakes districts.

Benchmarking the school – academically, culturally, sporting-wise – against Dunstan (Alexandra), Wakatipu (Queenstown) and Mt Aspiring (Wanaka) high schools would be a good start. The latter two have become very good schools, Dunstan is showing good progress under new leadership.

Many people will also not be aware that Cromwell College is a decile 8 school. So that sets an academic benchmark too – you can judge the school's NCEA results against like-deciled national schools. There's a very good website – www.educationcounts.govt.nz – that gives you a useful overview.

One other point needs to be made as well: schooling and education is becoming more important, not less. Kids without qualifications, or with lesser credentials, are going to have even worse opportunities in the future, than now.

That puts additional pressure upon both schools and parents. We all want the best for our children and schools are a vital part of that partnership. Get involved. Let them know what you want for your child.

It seems like a distant dream, until one day you wake up, and two of your three kids have left home.

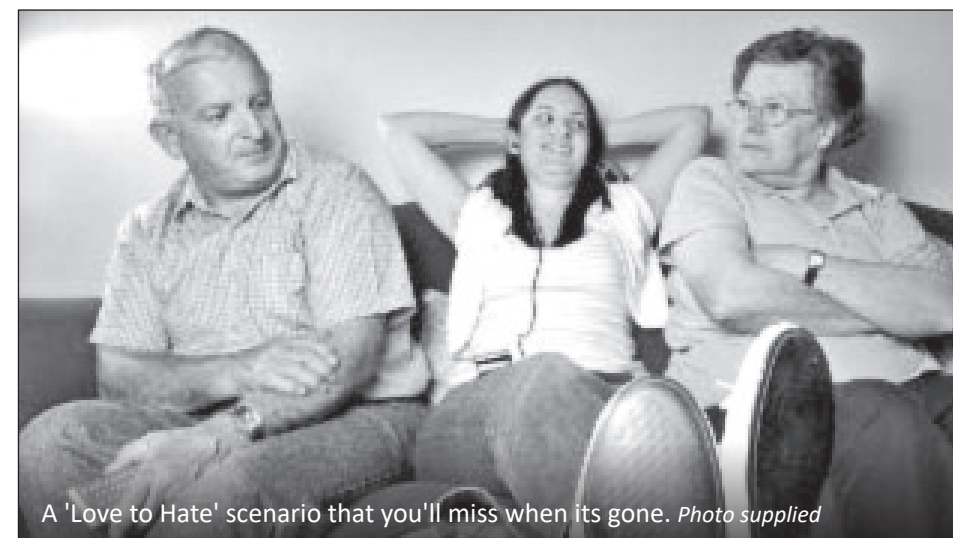
One bedroom becomes a home gym, the other, a meditation retreat filled with candles and pillows.

Mediterranean Stuffed Peppers

Serves 2-4 people

INGREDIENTS

2 red peppers, halved, deseeded with stalks on

½ Cup uncooked couscous, (food so nice they named it twice)

150mls of boiling water

¼ Cup toasted pine nuts

1 handful of roughly chopped black olives

¼ Cup of crumbled feta cheese

¼ Cup sundried tomatoes

A few cherry tomatoes

A few leaves of shredded basil and a drizzle or two of olive oil

METHOD

Heat oven to 200C.

Halve, deseed and wash peppers and place on a plate and microwave for 5 mins or until almost soft.

Place peppers on a baking tray with the cut side up.

Place couscous in a bowl and cover with boiling water, stir and cover, leaving to stand for ten minutes.

Once liquid has absorbed, fluff with a fork and stir through pine nuts, olives, feta, sundried tomatoes and basil.

Stuff the pepper shells and place slices of the cherry tomatoes on top, drizzle with a little olive oil, and bake in oven for 10 mins.

Delicious served with a salad as a vegetarian option, or as an alternative to regular vegetables with the evening meal.

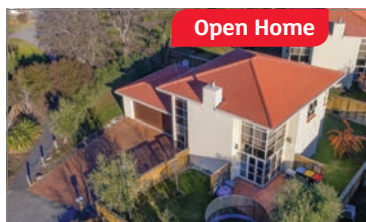
