It has been 26 days of meeting new people, trying new food, visiting new places and racing BMX for seven-year-old Charlie Leyser.

Charlie represented New Zealand at the UCI BMX World Championships, held at Novant Health BMX Supercross Track in Rock Hill, South Carolina, USA.

Having been racing for only nine months, Charlie has managed to place 30th in the World for his age group from the 78 riders competing.

"It's been a great time for Charlie, competition was at the next level, the intensity of each race was mind-blowing and the experience gained has been worth the hard work and training that's taken place.

"It comes down to having the Cromwell Bike Park at our fingertips.

Without it, Charlie would not have been out riding BMX every spare minute," says Charlie's Dad, Pierre Leyser.

Many Cromwell locals watched online during the night as the young champion took on the world.

Charlie's mother Sonia, and siblings Anika and Hamish who both race BMX themselves, were perhaps Charlie's

They watched each race throughout the campaign with full attention.

Charlie's overseas experience has left him with a wider view of the world, a deeper passion for BMX riding, and a great network of friends within the world BMX family.

New Zealand BMX Champion Sarah Walker was also on hand at South Carolina, and having opened the Cromwell Bike Park earlier in the year, was pleased to once again catch up with

Charlie and show her support. Charlie's dad said Charlie is now looking forward to relaxing. "We can now take a bit of time out, do a bit of mountain biking and take it easy for a while.

It's been pretty intense with training and competing and Charlie's looking forward to taking a couple of months off to kick back and hang out.

"We want to thank everyone for the local support. It's been a great trip and knowing Cromwell is right behind us has been great," adds Pierre.

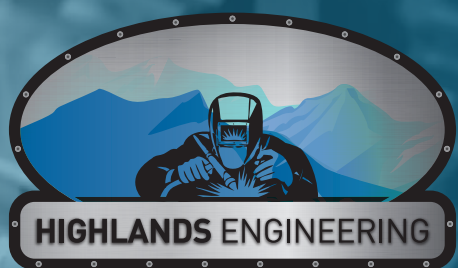

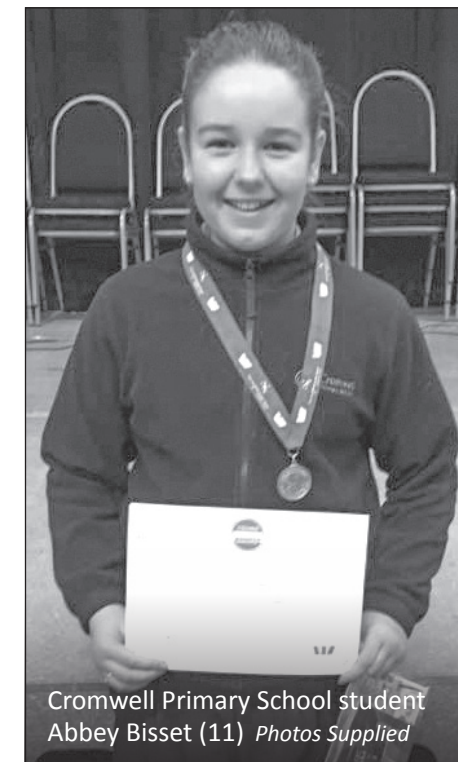
"Congratulations to Ariana who has consistently led by example, thought of her peers along the way and put her best foot forward in every area of her schooling life," she says.

First ever trophy win for Central shooters

The Central Otago region was well represented last weekend at the annual Andrew Faulkner Shield Challenge small bore shooting competition.

Members from the Clyde area club attended the day-long shoot held in Dunedin last Saturday.

Central Otago shooters achieved first place in the division two competition, beating three of the division one teams.

This is an outstanding effort from those who took part in the competition.

The club was able to bring home the highly sought after Lindsay Smith Trophy for the first time ever, and were then promoted to the division one grade at the expense of the Christchurch team.

Junior Central Otago shooters also enjoyed success, placing third in the competition.

"This is a great result from Central Otago shooters. We have secured the

cup with the only problem now being a trophy cabinet undersized to hold the trophy," said Central Otago Captain Garry Milford.

"It's been said before, 'a champion team can beat a team of champions'. The sum total of the parts was our strength and every point counted with a very strong finish," he adds.

The Central Otago team to take home the trophy consisted of shooters Bevan Todd and Paul Fox from Cromwell, along with other regional shooters Bruce Smith, Alistair Crossland, Garry Milford (team Captain) Jenna MacKenzie, Gerrard Dodd and reserves, Trevor Davis, Ken MacKenzie, Mark Paterson, Craig Still and Ernie Malaschnig.

Some members from the club will now attend an individual national shoot this weekend in Dunedin. Some members from the region were also selected to take part in an Otago team to challenge Southland on Saturday 12 August in Dunedin.

THE BIG FRUIT RESERVE... does it work?

About this time last year, work started on the Big Fruit Reserve – that block of land bordering the state highway and containing Cromwell's iconic piece of Kiwi kitsch – the Big Fruit sculpture.

As a newcomer to Cromwell, there seemed quite a pleasant drive into Cromwell one day ... and the next day ... well, there were diggers, netting fences and bare dirt was everywhere. And plenty of the latter for everyone, when the wind blew.

As a former local government bod though, I stilled my tongue. All construction looks ugly – it's the end result that makes for the judgement.

Although I was sympathetic to that perennial question popping up at the election meetings that followed – where's the cherry and where are the grapes?

Which are, actually, pretty good questions: if the sculpture is supposed to exhibit Cromwell's horticultural heritage, then the grape and the cherry are surely the source of her regeneration. If I were the community board, I wouldn't give up on that question.

I look now at the reserve – all grown, marked and highlighted – and I think that it's fine. But that it seems uncompleted – like it's waiting for the next stage.

Does it really achieve its purpose, in promoting Cromwell to passing traffic, and attracting them into our locale?

No doubt the Cromwell community board are asking that same question – they seem a sincerely motivated, balanced and intelligent group, so you would assume, that they are.

But I don't know. Which brings me to my next plea – could the community board communicate to us their general debates, decisions and findings?

Now, it's a request that you could reasonably direct at every local body organisation that services Cromwell – be they the community board, district council or regional council.

But it would be great if some monthly report was published by the board in our local community 'papers' – or on a specially designated Cromwell community board Facebook site. That way, we would all know.

And inform us all as to - what's going on? And, what's next? What do you think?

LEGAL SPEAK with Doreen Evans

Legal Speak: Building Boom Turning your payment claim into cash.

In the last article we said that we would discuss how a complying payment claim can help you get paid.

The payer becomes liable to pay all of the claimed amount when they receive a complying payment claim and do not dispute it within the relevant time and in accordance with the requirements of the Act.

If the payer does not pay on the due date then the issuer of the payment claim can immediately sue the Payer and claim all their actual and reasonable costs of recovery also. The debt may be claimed in any court. The debt-collection process is fast-tracked as the payer cannot dispute the amount claimed or the work completed. Until you received payment you have the right to suspend your construction work if you wish. Payment claims must follow the letter of the law and include

all details relating to the claim. Skipping a prescribed step or accidentally leaving out one bit of required information can be fatal to a payment claim.

Sometimes a technicality will invalidate your payment claim. For example, stating the amount payable but not providing an indication of how it was calculated would make the payment claim invalid.

We recommend you always use payment claims that comply with the Act.

If you are unsure whether your payment claim form does comply then get it checked so that you will always get paid.

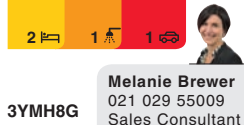
